## 1. Introduction

### Payment Information

- Billing details (processed securely through third-party providers)

  - Performance or training data (if applicable)

### 3. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Provide training, coaching, and related services
  - Communicate scheduling, updates, and program information
  - Ensure participant safety and appropriate training modifications
  - Process payments and manage accounts
  - Improve our services, programming, and user experience
  - Maintain legal and operational records

### 4. Sharing of Information

We do **not** sell your personal information.

We may share your information with:

- Coaches and staff for training and safety purposes
  - Medical or performance partners (e.g., physical therapy providers) when necessary
  - Payment processors and service providers
  - Legal authorities if required by law

### 5. Data Security

We take reasonable steps to protect your personal information using administrative, technical, and physical safeguards.

That said, no system is perfect. If someone really wants data badly enough, they usually find a way. We just make it as difficult as possible.

### 6. Retention of Information

We retain your information only as long as necessary to:

- Provide services
- Comply with legal obligations
- Resolve disputes
- Enforce agreements

## 7. Your Rights

Depending on your location, you may have the right to:

- Opt out of certain communications

For participants under 18, personal information must be provided and consented to by a parent or legal guardian.
